








You will get a chance to spot this beautiful antelope and may also spot other wildlife like the Chinkara, Blue bull, Desert fox, Hares or Partridges.

Between the months of September and March, you may witness thousands of migratory Demoiselle Cranes near the Guda Lake.

A quick stop at Salawas – the home to families of weavers who have been making cotton durries (rugs) for many years. Here you will interact with the weavers, watch them at work, and can also buy directly from them.
